

## Announcement of Jet Ski King's Cup - World Cup Grand Prix 2011

- For Categories 2 and 3, in case there are fewer than 6 nations competing in each category, the cash prizes will be US\$ 12,000/ 6,000/ 3,000 and the races will be open for more than 4 racers from each nation.
